<b>Screening</b> <i>Select if no symptoms of disease are present</i>	<b>Diagnostic</b> <i>Use if signs or symptoms present, confirmed disease state, or previous abnormal</i>
<b>Z01.411</b> Encounter for gyn exam (general)(routine) <b>with</b> abnormal findings	<b><u>Abnormal cytological findings in specimen from Cervix/Uteri</u></b>
<b>Z01.419</b> Encounter for gyn exam (general)(routine) <b>without</b> abnormal findings	<b>R87.610 Atypical</b> squamous cells of <b>undetermined significance</b> on cyto smear of cervix [ASC-US]
<b>Z12.4</b> Encounter for screening for malignant neoplasm of <b>cervix</b>	<b>R87.611 Atypical</b> squamous cells of cannot exclude <b>high grade</b> squamous intraepithelial lesion on cyto smear of cervix [ASC-H]
<b>Z12.72</b> Encounter for screening for malignant neoplasm of <b>vagina</b>	<b>R87.612 Low grade</b> squamous intraepithelial lesion on cyto smear of cervix [LGSIL]
<b>Pregnancy</b>	<b>R87.613 High grade</b> squamous intraepithelial lesion on cyto smear of cervix [HGSIL]
<b>Z34.00</b> Encounter for supervision of normal <b>first</b> pregnancy, <b>unspecified</b> trimester	<b>R87.614</b> Cytologic evidence of <b>malignancy</b> on smear of cervix.
<b>Z34.01</b> Encounter for supervision of normal <b>first</b> pregnancy, <b>first</b> trimester	<b>R87.618 Other abnormal</b> cytological findings on specimens from cervix uteri.
<b>Z34.02</b> Encounter for supervision of normal <b>first</b> pregnancy, <b>second</b> trimester	<b>R87.619 Unspecified abnormal</b> cytological findings in specimens for cervix uteri
<b>Z34.03</b> Encounter for supervision of normal <b>first</b> pregnancy, <b>third</b> trimester	<b><u>Female genital HPV test</u></b> <b><u>Other abnormal findings in specimens from female genital organs</u></b>
<b>Z34.80</b> Encounter for supervision of <b>other</b> normal pregnancy, <b>unspecified</b> trimester	<b><i>High risk human papillomavirus [HPV] DNA test positive from female genital organs</i></b>
<b>Z34.81</b> Encounter for supervision of <b>other</b> normal pregnancy, <b>first</b> trimester	<b>R87.810 Cervical</b> high risk human papillomavirus [HPV] DNA test positive
<b>Z34.82</b> Encounter for supervision of <b>other</b> normal pregnancy, <b>second</b> trimester	<b>R87.811 Vaginal</b> high risk human papillomavirus [HPV] DNA test positive
<b>Z34.83</b> Encounter for supervision of <b>other</b> normal pregnancy, <b>third</b> trimester	<b><i>Low risk human papillomavirus [HPV] DNA test positive from female genital organs</i></b>
<b>Z34.90</b> Encounter for supervision of normal pregnancy, <b>unspecified, unspecified</b> trimester	<b>R87.820 Cervical</b> low risk human papillomavirus [HPV] DNA test positive
<b>Z34.91</b> Encounter for supervision of normal pregnancy, <b>unspecified, first</b> trimester	<b>R87.821 Vaginal</b> low risk human papillomavirus [HPV] DNA test positive
<b>Z34.92</b> Encounter for supervision of normal pregnancy, <b>unspecified, second</b> trimester	<b>R87.89</b> Other abnormal findings in specimen from female genital organs
<b>Z34.93</b> Encounter for supervision of normal pregnancy, <b>unspecified, third</b> trimester	<b>R87.9</b> Unspecified abnormal finding in specimens from female genital organs

<b>Z39.2</b> Encounter for routine <b>postpartum</b> follow-up	<b>N87.1 Moderate cervical dysplasia</b>
